3 Step Plan

We encourage all children to follow our 3 Step Plan to stop bullying behaviour. This plan emphasises letting someone know they are annoying/hurting you without teasing/hitting etc. back. Telling others to stop their behaviour is pivotal to this plan. The steps are:



- 1. Firmly tell them to stop their behaviour because you don't like it.
2. If it continues: Ignore the behaviour and walk away.
If it continues: See an adult to help you solve the problem.

This plan does work when children follow it right through if needed. Please as parents also encourage your child to use our 3 Step Plan!
