Staffing Class Formations: 2017

Schools are staffed using an Education Department model that allocates teachers and support staff according to the number of students enrolled. For example, the ratio of teachers to students in the P - 3 years is lower than the ratio in the 4 - 6 years.

Between now and the Official Census Day - Day 8 of schooling in 2016 - we may have an influx of new enrolments or, alternatively, a number of families may move out. That would influence whether we retain the staff we have or gain/lose staff members.

At this stage, we will plan on 19 classes and these will be: 3 x Prep, 2 x Year 1, 1 x Year 1/2, 2 x Year 2, 3 x Year 3, 3 x Year 4, 1 x Year 5/6, 2 x Year 5 and 2 x Year 6.
