**Under this agreement for 2018
Woongarra State School will receive**

\$195,152*

This funding will be used to:

- Employ quality researched teaching and learning strategies which ensure all (100%) students in Years 3 and 5 achieve or exceed National Minimum Standard (NMS) in numeracy and literacy this year.
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Reading in Year 3 from 35% 2013 to 50% in 2018.
- Increase the percentage of students in U2B in Reading in Year 5 from 28% in 2013 to 35% in 2018.
- Increase the percentage of students in U2B in Numeracy in Year 3 from 34% 2013 to 40% in 2018.
- Increase the percentage of students in U2B in Numeracy in Year 5 from 11% in 2013 to 35% in 2018.

Our initiatives include:

- Reviewing student performance data each term in reading (PM and IPI benchmarking) and student performance data in annual testing of reading (NAPLAN and PAT R).
- Allocating additional human resources to differentiate learning.
- Reviewing early years speech/language data to target intervention programs.
- Providing professional development for staff to increase their repertoire of effective numeracy teaching strategies.
- Identifying and providing extension programs in Math and English for children in, or potentially in, U2B.
- Implementing the Early Start testing to track student progress.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Employing:

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| • 0.4 FTE Support Teacher Literacy/Numeracy to work with children across Years 1 - 5 | \$ 46,500 |
| • 0.2 FTE Master Teacher to build teacher capacity in Numeracy (0.8 FTE Master Teacher funding from Department of Education) | \$ 25,500 |
| • Additional teacher aides to support individual or small groups of students in targeted areas of Numeracy and Literacy | \$102,152 |
| • 0.1 FTE Speech Language Pathologist to build capacity of teachers and teacher aides, to provide specific resources and to support individual children | \$ 9,500 |
