## This funding will be used to

- Employ quality researched teaching and learning strategies which ensure 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 achieve or exceed NMS in reading, writing and numeracy by 2020
- Increase the percentage of students in the upper two bands for writing in Year 5 to 20% by 2020
- Increase the number of students in Prep – 3 achieving a 'C' or better in English to 85% by 2021

## Our initiatives include

- Reviewing the student performance data in Writing each term, during moderation of English units
- Providing professional development for staff to increase their repertoire of effective strategies for the teaching of writing
- Modelling strategies for teachers in demonstration lessons
- Providing extension programs in English and Maths for children in, or potentially in, the upper two bands
- Extending the Early Start tracking to Year 2
- Allocating additional human resources to differentiate learning, and to target intervention programs

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- 0.4 HOC to lead the development of writing across the school and to assist in building teacher capacity
- Additional teacher-aides to support individual and small groups of students in targeted areas of literacy
- 0.1 Speech Language Pathologist to build capacity of teachers and teacher-aides, and to provide support for individual and small groups of students
- Continuing the Early Start Assessment and extending it to Year 2
