This funding will be used to

- Employ quality researched teaching and learning strategies which ensure all (100%) students in Years 3 and 5 achieve and exceed National Minimum Standard in Numeracy and Literacy by 2015.
- Increase the percentage of students in the upper two bands in Reading in Year 3 from 28% 2011 to 38% in 2016.
- Provide support for all students in Prep to Year 2 to ensure students reach or exceed the National Minimum Standard in Literacy and Numeracy
- Provide student support programs in Literacy and Numeracy for those who will not reach the National Minimum Standard.

Our strategy will be to

- Review student performance data in each term in Reading (Reading benchmarking each term).
- Review student performance data in annual testing of Reading (NAPLAN and PAT-R).
- Allocate human/material resources to differentiate learning needs.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing:

0.4 Reading Coach to continue to build teacher capacity in the explicit teaching of reading.	\$52 000
0.2 Master Teacher to build teacher capacity in Numeracy (0.8 Master Teacher funding from DETE).	\$26 000
Teacher-aide support to work with small groups of students in targeted areas of numeracy and literacy.	\$48 000
