Under this agreement for 2022  
Woongarra SS will receive

**\$205,000\***

## This funding will be used to:

- Employ quality researched teaching and learning strategies which ensure 85% of students achieve A-C in English and Maths.
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands for English (A-B students) to 40%.

## Our initiatives include:

- Reviewing the student performance data in English each term, during moderation of English units.
- Providing professional development for staff to increase their repertoire of effective strategies for the teaching of Writing, including the CASW Process (Collaborative Assessment of Student Work); to examine feedback students need for success.
- Case-management Process to lift student results (CASW).
- Providing extension programs in Maths for children in, or potentially in, the Upper Two Bands.
- Early Start tracking Prep to Year 2.
- Allocating additional human resources to differentiate learning, and to target intervention programs.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Providing additional teacher aides to support individual and small groups of students in targeted areas of literacy	59,000
Continuing the Early Start Assessment in Prep to Year 2, to be conducted in Term 4	10,000
Audiologist Testing of all Prep students	1,000
TRS Support for Teachers Planning/Assessment including non-contact time	40,000
Teacher 0.3 to support HODC class	40,000
Behaviour Support Teacher Aide	20,000
Professional Development	35,000
